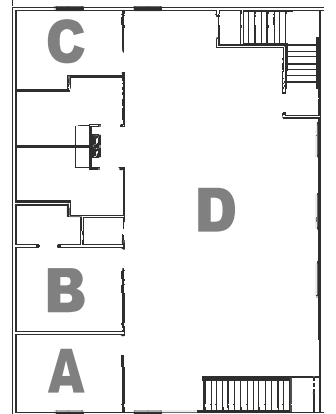
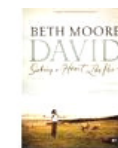


Diagram of the upstairs portion of the new building
